### Computer-Based Examinations

We are pleased to announce that the Board will begin offering computer-based examinations on May 1, 2001. The Board has contracted with Assessment Systems, Inc. (ASI), a national testing company that provides a variety of licensing and certification services to regulatory agencies, to administer the computer-based examinations. ASI has six examination centers in the following cities: Asheville, Statesville, Huntersville, Raleigh, Wilmington and New Bern. You will have the convenience of contacting ASI to schedule your examination at any of these locations on a date that is suitable for you. You may contact ASI by one of the following methods:

1. You may call to make your appointment as far in advance as is convenient, and as early as three business days in advance for desired time (Phone number will be available at a later date).
2. You may register by fax (Fax number will be available at a later date). Faxed reservations must be received at least four business days before the desired examination date. A confirmation of the reservation will be transmitted within twenty-four hours.
3. You may register by internet (web address will be available at a later date).

All scheduling depends on seat availability. It would be a good idea before scheduling your examination to have a few alternate dates in mind.

Upon arrival at the Assessment Center, you will report to the Assessment Center Manager. You will be asked to present your confirmation number, photo-bearing and signature bearing identification. You will then be assigned a seat. You will then have the opportunity to go through a tutorial on the computer. The Assessment Center Manager may also answer any questions you may have pertaining to the computer system. Code books, calculators and any other required materials will be provided.

You will be given a fixed period of time to complete the examination. This time varies according to the specific examination you are taking.

When examination has been completed official scoring of the examination will begin immediately. Failing candidates may request reviews by applying to the Board. A request form will be included with failing score reports. If examinee does not pass the examination, examinee will be informed of their total score along with their performance of the eleven major sections of the examination. If examinee passes the examination, they will receive their score report certificate and photo-bearing wallet identification. Passing applicants will need to contact the Board's office for licensing procedures.

The Board's last pencil & paper examination will be held in September 2001.

## 2002 NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE

As with previous NEC editions, it is anticipated that the North Carolina State Building Code Council will adopt the 2002 National Electrical Code as the State Electrical Code effective January 1, 2002. With this effective date, the Board's qualifying examinations will be based on the 1999 National Electrical Code until June 30, 2002. *Effective July 1, 2002, the Board's examinations will be based on the 2002 National Electrical Code.*

The Board has ordered a supply of the 2002 National Electrical Code book (soft-bound cover) at a special prepublication price. We expect delivery of the code books in August/September 2001. The code books are available to examinees, licensees, inspectors and others who may wish to purchase copies at discounted prices.

Renewal applications received after June 30, 2001 will be subject to a \$25.00 late renewal fee. A 2001-2002 renewal application will be mailed to each licensee. ## CHANGE OF ADDRESS REMINDER

A recent mail out from the Board to licensees and other recipients on our mailing list resulted in several hundred returns due to expired addresses. You are reminded that Board's Rule .0402 (c) requires that all licensees shall notify the Board in writing within 30 days of any change in location or mailing address and telephone.

## CONTINUING EDUCATION

You are reminded that, pursuant to G.S. 87-44.1 and Section .1100 of the Board's Rules, every qualified individual with an Unlimited, Intermediate, Limited or SP-SFD license shall complete eight contact hours of approved continuing education prior to June 30, 2001, to renew the license on which you are currently listed for the fiscal year July 1, 2001 – June 30, 2002. Qualified individuals currently listed on a license in the special restricted SP-LV, SP-EL SP-PH, SP-WP, SP-ES and SP-SP classifications shall complete at least four hours of approved continuing education for license renewal.

Please remember to take your continuing education course as early as possible to avoid delays in processing your 2001-2002 license renewal.

**VIOLATION(S):** Violation of North Carolina General Statute 87-47 (a1) (1), (5) and (7) in that the licensee engaged in an electrical contracting project which exceeded the limitations of his firms limited electrical contracting license.

**BOARD ACTION:** This matter was heard before the Disciplinary Committee of the Board. After hearing from the licensee and counsel, the Committee recommended that:

- (1) License to engage in business as an electrical contractor be placed on probation for a period of three-(3) years, effective upon final action by the Board.
- (2) During the period of probation, licensee shall comply with the following conditions of probation:
  - (a) have written contracts or proposals signed by the licensee and customer for each installation for which licensee is responsible having a value in excess of one hundred dollars (\$100.00);
  - (b) obtain permits as required for each contract prior to commencement of work, retain a copy of the permit in the job file for each particular installation and assure that a final inspection has been performed by the local Code Enforcement Official for each installation;
  - (c) maintain job files or other written records of contracts made and installations performed;
  - (d) submit quarterly reports documenting his compliance with the provisions of this probation order by either sending them directly to the Board's office or contacting the Board's Field Representative that the documents are ready for his review;
  - (e) obtain no draw on a project for labor or material exceeding, in the aggregate, fifty-(50) percent of the contract price prior to final passage of final inspection; and
  - (f) enter into no contract beyond the limited scope of his license.

There was no objection from the licensee and the Board approved the recommendation.

**VIOLATION(S):** Violation of North Carolina General Statute 87-47 (a1) (7), 87-43.4 and Board Rule .0402 (b) in that the licensee:

- (1) Exceeded the scope of his residential dwelling license (SP-SFD) in that electrical contracting work was performed on a project other than a single-family detached residential dwelling;
- (2) Commenced work on the project without first obtaining the required permit from the local Code Enforcement Official;
- (3) Installed electrical contracting work with violations of the State Electrical Code (1999 National Electrical Code), including:
  - (a) Installed receptacles having polarity problems;
  - (b) Installed receptacles not having grounding continuity; and
  - (c) Installed nonmetallic-sheathed cable (romex) in cabinets without proper protection.
- (4) Had been operating in a name different from the name under which the license was issued.

**BOARD ACTION:** Pursuant to G. S. 87-47 (a2) and (a3) and 21 NCAC 18B .0902, the Board's staff proposed a reprimand, a civil penalty of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) and a two-(2) year probation. The specific conditions of the probation period are that no further violation of Article 4, Chapter 87 of the General Statutes or the rules of the Board occur, permits be acquired for all work carried out by the firm unless relieved by the local Code Enforcement Official, written contracts or proposals be utilized for all work in excess of one hundred dollars (\$100.00), the estimated completion date appear on the contract or proposal and that licensee have written receipts for all money paid or received. The Board concurred in the action of staff.
